

HCC Wind Turbine Technology Admission Scoring

The applicant is responsible for:

- Meeting Highland Community College admission requirements;
- Taking the Highland Community College placement test and place into MATH 065 and COMM 090 or above
or
have the following minimum ACT scores: 20 in Reading and 22 in English and 23 in Math
- Returning the completed application for Wind Turbine Technology admission form to the Business & Technology Division Office Coordinator;
- Submitting required documentation for Wind Turbine Technology admission to the Business & Technology Division Office Coordinator, as follows:
 - Application
 - Appropriate letters of recommendation
 - Copy of an original transcript(s) from all college level courses attended including Highland Community College
 - Typed, personal statement
 - Proof of current service or discharge from the armed forces
